The scholar would be invited to engage in discussion with faculty and postgraduate students, exploring pioneering opportunities for increasing research impact with diverse audiences and examining new methods of research dissemination and research led/informed teaching. The Scholar would be encouraged to deliver events (lectures, seminars, workshops etc.) exploring research impact, external/public engagement, and innovative forms of research dissemination and research led teaching. The Scholar would also be encouraged to provide one-to-one meetings with staff and students who are seeking to increase the impact of their research through innovative forms of dissemination and incorporate this research into their curricula. Activities would consist of approximately two to four hours per week and would be aimed at staff and graduate students. Scholars will be asked to give public talks, mentor students, and otherwise engage with the host community, in addition to their primary research or teaching activities.
