The award holder will teach one graduate course per semester on a topic of their choosing. The course, a research proseminar, will consist of 135-minute sessions, once a week, for 15 weeks. The Distinguished Scholar will also be expected to give public lectures, advise graduate students, and generally engage in the academic life of the ASC.

The Distinguished Scholar can be awarded only to preeminent American Studies scholars with an outstanding publication record in their fields. Candidates are expected to have an extensive teaching experience.

It is expected that the candidate will hold a Ph.D. in the humanities or social sciences and have at least 10 years of teaching experience.

## **Additional Language Requirement**

All teaching will be in English; Spanish optional and may be used to teach graduate students at the MA level.

## **Invitation Requirement**

A letter of invitation is preferred.

### **Additional Comments**

The ASC offers a unique, interdisciplinary American Studies program. At the BA level, it focuses on the US American Studies, at the MA it offers a highly individualized, research-oriented curriculum allowing graduate students to specialize in the culture, society, and politics of either the United States or the wider Western Hemisphere, including countries of Latin America. All courses in English, unless Spanish is the choice of all the students in an elective course.

The American Studies Center employs nearly 60 faculty, 31 of whom are permanent faculty, from Poland, the United States, and Mexico. It provides excellent research facilities for students, scholars, and professionals interested in the field. The ASC Library is the largest American Studies library in Central Europe, attracting researchers from across the world.

The ASC promotes American Studies in Poland and Europe by conducting research, hosting conferences, debates and various events open to the general public and by being active in several US American Studies and Latin American Studies associations (Polish Association for American Studies [PAAS], European Association for American Studies [EAAS], American Studies Network [ASN], Consejo Europeo de investigaciones sociales de América Latina [CEISAL]).
