Award Activity

The award holder will be expected to teach one regular course for undergraduate/graduate students as well as a more specialized seminar for PhD students at the Faculty of Architecture of the Tadeusz Kosciuszko Cracow University of Technology (PK). The awarded scholar will be encouraged to give talks at PK Faculty of Architecture as well as participate in collaborative research with PK scholars. Preferred division of responsibilities between the two activities in case of teaching/research awards is 50% teaching and 50% research.

Award Dates

Award is offered for **4, 5 or 9 months (a semester or an academic year)**.

Since the academic year in Poland starts in October, grants cannot start prior to that date. One-semester grants must begin either in October 2022 or February 2023; two-semester grants must begin in October 2022.

This award is intended for eminent scholars with an excellent record of publications in their respective fields, significant teaching experience, and experience mentoring PhD students. The candidates should be academics with at least M.Arch or M.S. in Arch Design and have preferably 10 or more years of teaching experience.

Additional Language Requirement

Additional language study would facilitate contacts with professionals at the host institution and would enable deeper engagement within the community and general well-being in the host country. We also recommend that candidates familiarize themselves with the culture of the host region. Therefore, prior language study is highly recommended.

Invitation Requirement

A letter of invitation is preferred.
