Monthly stipend of €6,250 for a total of €25,000 for four months (approximately \$7,380 and \$29,518, the amounts may change depending on exchange rate fluctuations). The award, which is a maintenance allowance for the entire period, is disbursed in Euro currency.

International Travel allowance of €1,100 (approximately \$1,300, the amount may change depending on exchange rate fluctuations). The allowance is disbursed in Euro currency.

Award Activity

The scholar will teach one course at the graduate level - four to six hours per week. The main style of teaching will be based on workshops, classes, labs, or business-case discussions. Average class size is approximately 60 students.

The specifics of the course will be decided depending on the specialization of the scholar. The scholar is required to draft the syllabus by the Spring 2022 (s/he will be informed by the hosting Department).

The scholar will also be required to hand in a final evaluation of students (based on a written test, paper, or final interview and class discussion) at the end of the course.

Classes are usually held on two or three days, with the rest of the week free for individual research and other activities.

Other activities:

The university heartily recommends the development of joint research activities and collaboration with Luiss Guido Carli University in Rome (LUISS) professors.

The scholar will be able to conduct research with LUISS professors, and participate in or lead seminars or Ph.D. lectures at LUISS University and other universities or institutions linked to LUISS University.

During the grant, the scholar may also be invited to take part in academic meetings, conferences, seminars, and other program-related activities organized by the University.

Academics wishing to pursue collaborative research projects and/or establish partnerships with their universities are welcome.

Assistance in finding a suitable accommodation in Rome will be provided. Approximate monthly cost for an apartment ranges around \$1.300-\$1.700. The University will also facilitate access to restaurants, sports facilities, health structures, shops, and theaters.
