Question	Answer
I had a few questions. If you have had a previous Senior Specialist position - are you eligible again? Is there a limit- like has to be X years ago?	You may reapply for a US Scholar award 2 years after completing your grant
Also, must you currently be a full-time academic?	You do not have to be a full-time academic!
Will the PPT and/or recording be sent to people who registered?	Yes!
Are there awards for non-US citizens as well (like from Canada)?	This program (the Fulbright US Scholar Program) is only for US citizens.
Would you recommend applicants choose a single opportunity to apply for or apply for more than one potential placement?	You may only apply to one award per cycle.
Can dependents include parents?	In some cases, yes!
Which specific Western Hemisphere options provide dependent support?	Hi! Is naturalized citizenship, ok?	Yes!
Do we receive W2/1099 form from Fulbright the following year? Do we pay the tax to other country as well?	Hi! We are unable to give tax advice, and we encourage all of our grantees to get in touch with the IRS directly in order to make sure their taxes are in order.
I am interested in applying to the Global Scholar Award including a visit to a country in Europe. Can you help me identify which countries are accepting 1-2 months long visits? Should I look for those with Flex=Yes or Multi-Country = Yes?	Look for countries with Flex options!
Did she say PhD required? I'm a full professor, but highest degree is Master of Science in structural engineering	Terminal degree is sometimes required, but many awards also allow for non-terminal degree holders to apply!
