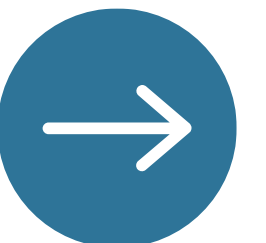

Fulbright-Hays Programs



Doctoral Dissertation Research Abroad (DDRA)

DDRA programs funds fellowships to colleges and universities to individual doctoral students who conduct research overseas, in modern foreign languages and area studies for periods of six to 12 months





Faculty Research Abroad (FRA)
The FRA program provides grants to institutions of higher education to fund faculty to maintain and improve their area studies and language skills by conducting research abroad for periods of 3 to 12 months.





Seminars Abroad (SA)

SA are short-term study and travel oversees seminars for U.S. educators in the social sciences and humanities for the purpose of improving their understanding and knowledge of the peoples and cultures of other countries.



Group Projects Abroad (GPA)
GPA provides grants to support overseas projects in training, research, and curriculum development in modern foreign languages and area studies for teachers, students, and faculty.

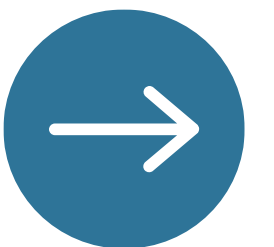

- Every program has a Minority Serving Institution Priority which offers bonus points for these institutions

- Three new SA seminars will be held in summer 2025 –application anticipated in early fall 2024.

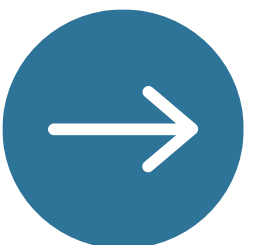
